Something wonderful is happening in a remote northern region of Zimbabwe, but getting there isn't easy. From the USA it can take about 35 to 40 hours of travel to get to Karanda Mission Hospital. When I got off the plane in Harare airport, I struck up a conversation with the lady in front of me. "Oh I've heard of the good things happening at Karanda and I want to go there to see myself!" Later in customs, another man said " This is so great, we love Karanda Mission place, thank you for coming!" So many wonderful people in the region have been touched by the loving care given by the Doctors and Nurses, who are making the compassionate instructions of Jesus to His followers a reality in the lives of those who need help. With 150 beds, Karanda Mission Hospital handles 4,000 surgeries each year serving 75,000 individuals annually. It has a School of Nursing and it is known for treating various conditions including HIV/AIDS, TB, obstetrics, chronic disease, and trauma. God is truly at work here through His loving followers, who come from all over the world to serve people!

## God is doing amazing things in this place!




